Land trust acquires second easement

CONWAY — The Upper Saco Valley Land Trust has acquired a second conservation easement.

The property, belonging to James Cobbs, is a 2.4 acre parcel of waterfront property on the southern shore of Conway Lake, in South Conway. The easement ensures that this property will remain undeveloped, thereby protecting the forested nature of the shoreline of Conway Lake forever. This very generous donation enhances the efforts of other landowners in this region who

have already placed nearby properties under conservation easement.

The Upper Saco Valley Land Trust is a local, membership-supported, non-profit organization dedicated to preserving open space for public benefit.
